

Divers to Go After '43 Air Crash Bodies

FRESNO, July 30—Army Corps of Engineers divers will attempt next week to recover the bodies of six men entombed for 17 years in the wreckage of a B24 bomber.

San Francisco Presidio Mortuary Supervisor George Casellis, who made a preliminary survey of the wreckage yesterday, said divers would be used before any other recovery method was tried.

The plane crashed in a remote lake in the Kings National Forest on Dec. 6, 1943.

The wreckage was discovered earlier in the week by Park Ranger Leroy Brock.
